



Mrs. Robbie Colene Mosley

December 1, 1944 - March 10, 2023

Robbie Colene Grier Mosley, the only child of Mildred Grier, was born on December 1, 1944 in Gastonia, N.C. She was raised in a loving extended family which included her adored Big Mama, beloved Aunt Bundt and her “sister cousin,” Jymmie while her mom worked in Newark, New Jersey to support her.

Robbie attended, excelled and graduated with high honors from the Gastonia public schools. She went on to study at North Carolina Central University in Durham, N.C. obtaining a Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology, graduating Magna Cum Laude.

Robbie moved to New Jersey, living with her mother and began a career at New Jersey Bell Telephone Company becoming one of the first Black customer service representatives.

Robbie met and united in marriage with Randolph (Randy) Mosley. From this union, Tamika Davon Mosley was born. Her love for learning expanded to her own child, then she desired to share it with others. Robbie went back to school, matriculating at Kean University to get certification in elementary education.

From 1980 until Robbie departed this earthly life, she touched the lives of many children and others in teaching and learning. She was employed by The Black Youth Organization, Inc., the parent organization of The Chad School—a forerunner and pioneer in private charter school education—in Newark NJ and The Chad Science Academy as a teacher, vice principal and guidance

counselor administrator.
